- The parish population has grown to 360, that is up by around 15% over the last 20 years
- Nearly 30% of residents are aged 65 or over that is nearly twice as many than in 2001
- There are 150 dwellings in the Parish 30 more than in 2001
- In 2001 13% of households had three or more cars by 2021 that was 25%
- There are 19 Listed buildings in the parish all are Grade II except the Grade I Church
- There are three Sites of Special Scientific Interest in the Parish plus Stanstead Great Wood which is a County Wildlife Site.





Within the Parish we have two "settlement boundaries" as shown by the red lines below. These were originally defined by Babergh DC in their 2006 Local Plan and have not been updated since. The boundaries are now considerably out of date, especially after the new housing at High Banks/St Mary's View. In principle, development is permitted (subject to planning permission) within the settlement boundaries. Outside of the settlement boundaries, development will only be permitted in specified circumstances.
